Tribute to Dr. Ursula Franklin

WinSETT and CCWESTT will honour pre-eminent scientist Dr. Ursula Franklin at the CCWESTT 2018 Biennial Conference in Edmonton, May 31-June 2. *“Dr. Ursula Franklin received her Ph.D. in experimental physics at the Technical University of Berlin in 1948. She came to Canada the following year and began a distinguished scientific career in Toronto. In 1967, she joined the University of Toronto's Department of Metallurgy and Materials Science, becoming a full professor in 1973. Dr. Franklin published more than 70 scholarly papers and major contributions to books on the structure and properties of metals and alloys, and the history and social impact of technology*

Ursula Franklin's 1989 Massey Lectures have been published in her book, *The Real World of Technology.* Dr. Franklin passed away on July 22, 2016 at the age of 94.
